

Tulip Shawl/Blanket

Key:

- | knit 1
 - yarn over
 - λ slip 1 stitch, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over (or ssk)
 - ∧ knit two together
 - ⋈ slip 1 stitch, knit two together, pass slipped stitch over
 - ⋈ knit 3 together
 - ⊗ make one by knitting through the front and the back of the same stitch
- I need to fix the pattern to get rid of those make ones.

All uncharted rows are knit plain (or purled if you want to try it in garter stitch).

This is a chart for a quarter of a square piece. I knit this on small gauge needles as a baby blanket. It would probably do well knit on larger gauge needles as a lighter shawl. Or, heck, try it with bulky yarn and make something big and warm. I've also wondered how the pattern would work in garter stitch. You could knit it as a triangle shawl if you repeated each row of the chart twice and added border stitches, skipping the diamond chain stitches at the beginning and end of each row of the shawl (just leaving the middle chain).
